About ENs and the EN Report Card

An EN is a private or public entity that participates in the [Ticket to Work](#) program and provides employment, vocational rehabilitation, or other support services to persons who receive Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) and/or Supplemental Security Income (SSI) benefits because of a disability. The [EN Report Card](#) helps beneficiaries make informed choices regarding their selection of an EN under the [Ticket to Work](#) program. The report card is essential to informing ENs about the service expectations and level of satisfaction of [Ticket to Work](#) participants and identifies areas in which it may improve performance under the program.

We have already received some input from the public which we have taken into consideration in drafting a proposed revision.
