

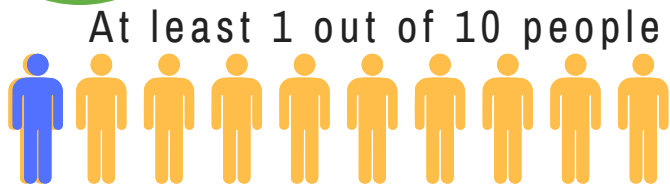

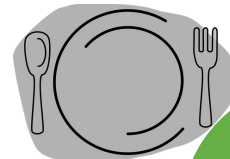
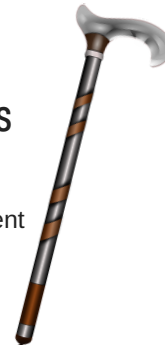
Not voting Due to Illness or Disability

1 out of every 5 Montanans with a disability is Native American.

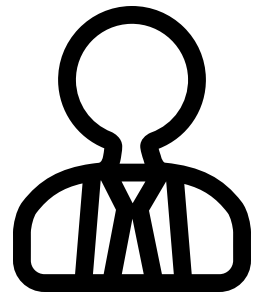
